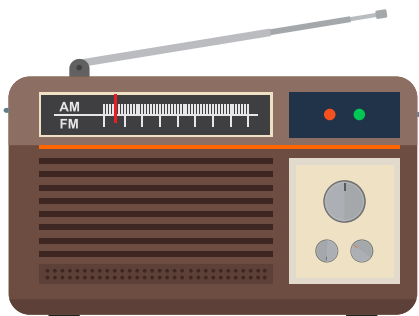

THE GOLDEN AGE OF RADIO 1930-1940s

“The convergence of talent, advertising sponsorships, and technological advancements in radio receivers, coordinated by the formation of radio networks, brought about the Golden Age of Radio (considered to be the period from 1930 through the late 40s.)

The Golden Age of Radio saw the formation of new types of entertainment: radio plays, detective serials, cooking shows, soap operas, quiz shows, variety and talent shows, situation comedies, children’s shows, comic strip adaptations, live music concerts, live sports events, news and news headlines, weather reports, remote/field reporting, sidewalk interviews and panel shows all began in radio.

The Golden Age of Radio relied heavily on talent from vaudeville and Hollywood. Early radio stars included: Abbott and Costello, Jack Benny, Bing Crosby, Jimmy Durante, Bob Hope, Groucho Marx, Red Skelton and many more.”
